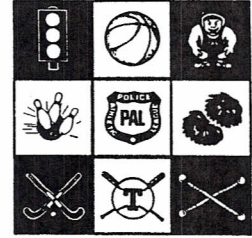

15. Walking on right of sidewalk, crosswalk, in halls.
16. Dangers of playing outside after dark.
17. Proper procedure when crossing railroad tracks.
18. Dangers of trains.
19. Colors, shapes and meanings of safety signs.
20. Dangers of chasing a ball into the street.
21. Safe places to play.
22. Proper way to use playground equipment.
23. Bus procedure.
24. Proper way to enter and exit car on curb side.
25. Proper way to behave in the car.
26. Importance of fastening his safety belt.
27. Dangers of household objects, medicine bottles, etc.
28. Bicycle, tricycle and pedal car safety.
29. Who strangers are and what to do if approached.
