## Seniors Scholarship Program Application

Graduating seniors, who participated in Hamilton Police Athletic League programs, are eligible for scholarships towards a college education ranging from \$1,500 to \$500. The distribution of the scholarships among the nominees will be determined by the Hamilton PAL Board of Directors based upon a review of the applications, high school transcripts, standardized test scores, letters of recommendation, and personal interviews by the Board.

To qualify, a student must meet the following requirements:

- 1. be a graduating senior with the intention to attend a college or university after graduation;
- 2. have participated in a Hamilton PAL sponsored program that includes Safety Town, T-Ball, Cheerleading, Twirling, Boys Basketball, Girls Basketball, Wrestling, Bowling, Girls Field Hockey, Football and Street Hockey; and,
- 3. have demonstrated a commitment to academic achievement and personal growth in high school through academic performance, participation in athletics, and other extracurricular activities or community service.

The following questions and information are necessary for the Board to determine your eligibility for and the amount of the scholarship. The information will be kept confidential and will only be reviewed by the Board of Directors who will make the final determinations. Attach additional sheets if necessary.
